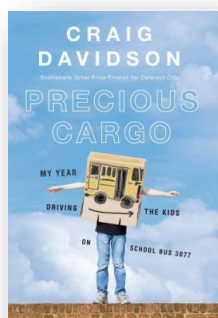
Featured Fiction Books



Anton Svensson was the second of four brothers. His father was a nice guy except if he had been drinking and explosives were involved, which unfortunately was often. To Svensson's father, loyalty was absolute and that meant not ratting out your kin, even if they were robbing banks, stashing military weapons in the floorboards or lobbing Molotov cocktails to burn down the home of his estranged wife, who was their mother. Svensson teamed up with writer Anders Roslund to write not a memoir but a crime novel that explores the emotional bonds and motivations at work in the family. This is the story of the violent life of Svensson's father and three brothers who spent 22 years in jail for their crimes. Only the names have been changed.

Anyone who has ridden a school bus knows it is the smallest of social ecosystems. Friendships are formed, secrets are whispered, romances bloom and fade, and—if a well-run bus—peace reigns. Desperate for solvency, Craig Davidson discovered himself behind the wheel of such a bus—with the notable difference that all his charges were children with disabilities. Though uncomfortable with the myriad of challenges these students had in their lives, he agreed to be their gatekeeper, gradually becoming a proud advocate and friend. Relishing their perspective and humour, Davidson was driven to examine society's disquiet around the differently abled. The resulting work, *Precious Cargo*, is an “eye-opening, funny” and unique “tale of redemption.” This is a bus ride that you won't want to miss.
